Saltaire

Saltaire is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, best known for its stunning Victorian architecture and the historic Salts Mill. The village is full of character, with a great mix of independent cafés, bars, and shops to explore. Just across the road you'll find Roberts Park, perfect for relaxing or catching community events, and the nearby Leeds–Liverpool Canal offers scenic walks and cycling routes that make the most of the area's heritage and natural beauty.

Getting to Salts Mill

You can reach Salts Mill easily by public transport or car. Saltaire train station is right on the doorstep, with regular services running from both Leeds and Skipton, making it a convenient option. If you're driving, there's plenty of free parking available on site, accessed via Salts Mill Road. To access the free car parks, please use: **BD17 7DR**.
